Answer: The Mid-Atlantic region includes the State of New York and has its origin in the 18th Century, and its states were each among the Thirteen Colonies of pre-revolutionary British America. The Mid-Atlantic region played an instrumental and historic role in the nation’s founding and the development of the nation.

What is the town of Gloversville known for?

Gloversville was once the hub of the United States’ glovemaking industry, with over two hundred manufacturers in Gloversville and the adjacent city of Johnstown. Glovemaking operations had gradually changed from being home-based to being factory-based, and large tanneries and glove shops employed nearly 80% of the residents of Gloversville area.
