

Why is this called the "Crewe Callers School"?

Answer: Crewe was founded in 1888 as a central location to house steam locomotive repair shops for the Norfolk & Western Railroad (now called Norfolk Southern) which has a rail yard there for east—west trains carrying Appalachian coal to Hampton Roads for export abroad, and the street pattern was laid out at that time. It was named after the large railroad town of Crewe, England.

There is still an active rail yard and an interesting railroad museum.
